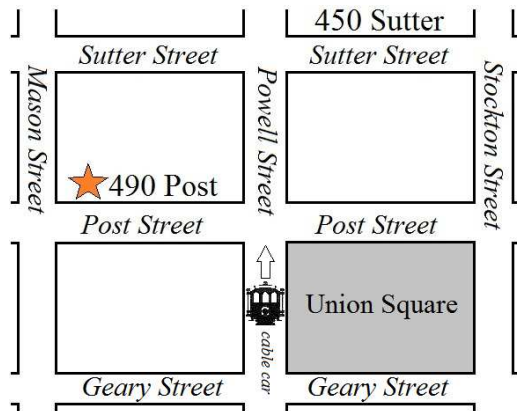

Parking is in the building around the corner at 520 Mason Street. Approach from Sutter Street as Mason is one-way. Parking is \$7.50 for first hour

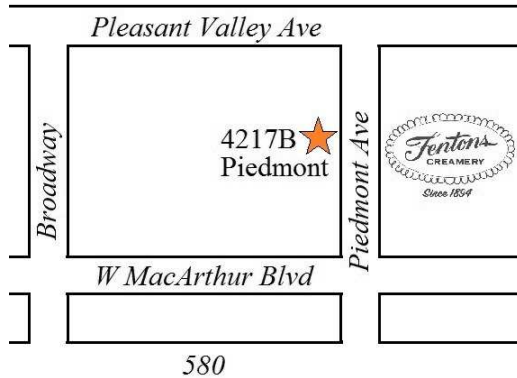
BART and MUNI: exit Powell Street station, follow cable car line four blocks up Powell St. to Post. Left on Post and walk one block: last building on the right

Directions from 101: If going south (from Palo Alto), exit 85 South; in 2 miles exit 237 West. If going north (from San Jose), exit 237 West. 237 ends at a stoplight. Turn right on El Camino and at the next stoplight, Calderon, turn right and the next right into parking behind Smiles Dental.

Directions from 280: Exit 85 North towards Mountain View, then follow the below directions

Directions from 85: Exit El Camino Real North toward Mountain View. Cross Grant Road. Turn right at the next stoplight (Calderon); make the next right into parking lot behind Smiles Dental.

Directions from El Camino: We're at the only stoplight between Castro Street and Grant Road.

Going south (coming from Palo Alto), after crossing Castro get into the left lane. Turn left at the Phyllis/Calderon light and make the first right into the Smiles Dental parking lot.

Going north (coming from Sunnyvale), after you cross Grant Road get in the right lane. Turn right at the Calderon stoplight; make the next right into the parking lot behind Smiles Dental.

FAQs

How long will this take? Usually 30 minutes or less. If we're also scanning your dentures allow 45 minutes.

How much radiation is used? We are the only local imaging facility to use low-radiation dental CTs, and we can minimize the exposure down to a small area of the mouth. Our hospital-certified Technologists adjust the dosage for each patient. The machine also emits radiation in quick pulses, further minimizing exposure.

What is the cost? The cost varies based on what scan is ordered. Call us for a quote. We request payment at time of service and we accept credit cards and checks.

Will insurance cover this? Sometimes medical insurance will (except Medicare and Kaiser), and we'll help you. We still bill you at time of scan. We copy your insurance information and submit it for you. If medical insurance pays we send you a reimbursement check. For dental insurance, we give you a receipt that you submit. If covered, dental reimburses you directly.
